

Internship in Jared Polis' Congressional Office

Position Description:

As an intern in a congressional office, the intern's primary responsibilities revolve around serving the constituents of Colorado's 2nd Congressional District (constituent services). His/her duties generally fall under one of three constituent-oriented categories: casework, correspondence and/or communication, and outreach. Correspondence/communication can happen either in person (a constituent phones or comes into the office), or in writing (a constituent sends a letter, an email, or a fax). Many of the incoming calls are from constituents who aren't happy about something the congressman or the government has done or is doing.
